Sunscreen Use Parent/Student Permission Form

Pennsylvania Act 105 of 2018 allows school students to possess, apply, and use topical sunscreen during school hours and at school-sponsored activities if the form below is completed and submitted to the school. Parents/guardians may choose to supply their child with a **non-aerosol** sunscreen that is approved by the FDA for over-the-counter use for purposes of limiting ultraviolet light-induced sun damage.

As a **parent/guardian**, I attest to the following:

- My child has demonstrated to me that he/she is capable of self-applying the non-aerosol sunscreen product.
- I understand that Northern Potter School District is not responsible for ensuring that the sunscreen product is applied by my child.
- I understand that the school may revoke or restrict possession, application, and use of sunscreen by my child if my child fails to comply with school rules related to the sunscreen product or if my child shows an unwillingness or inability to safeguard the non-aerosol topical sunscreen product from access by other students.
